Dear Friends of Freedom:

Today, those of us listed below—representing a broad cross-section of the conservative movement—are endorsing Douglas Hoffman for Congress from the 23rd district of New York.

We are convinced that Doug Hoffman represents the clearest choice for those citizens who believe the current administration and Congress in Washington are out of control and out of touch.
